Announcement of Australia Awards Scholarships Applications for Study in 2027

Dear Mr Adhikari

I am pleased to advise that the Australian Government will open applications for Australia Awards Scholarships for master's degree programs commencing in 2027 from 2 February to 30 April 2026. Through these scholarships, we continue to support Nepal's long-term human resource and institutional development.

In line with Nepal's development priorities, we have identified nine priority sectors for the 2027 intake:

- Climate Change
- Disaster Risk Reduction
- Economic Development
- Education
- Gender Equality, Disability and Social Inclusion
- Governance
- Mental Health and Rehabilitation Therapies
- Natural Resource Management
- Sustainable Infrastructure Development

We ask applicants to ensure that their proposed study program directly contributes to one of these sectors.

We require applicants to meet all eligibility requirements. These include residence in Nepal; holding a four-year bachelor's degree or a master's degree; completing at least three years of relevant professional experience after finishing their bachelor's degree; and meeting the English language test requirement. Applicants can access full details at <https://australiaawardsnepal.org/>.

We encourage women, people with disability, people from marginalised groups, and people from sexual and gender minorities to apply as part of our strong commitment to inclusion. We will select scholars based on merit.

The Australia Awards team will deliver online information sessions to support prospective applicants. We will also run a dedicated session for civil service officials on Friday, 13 February 2026. Civil service officials can register through the website noted above.




